**OLD BUSINESS**

**221 SAWTELLE AVENUE**

Request from Councilor DuBois that a “Go Slow Children” sign be installed in the vicinity of 221 Sawtelle Avenue.

**After Subcommittee review, it was noted that “Watch Children” signs are already placed in that immediate vicinity, as follows:**

**Northerly at 9 Sawtelle Avenue;  
Northerly at 49 Sawtelle Avenue;  
Northerly at 161 Sawtelle Avenue;  
Southerly at 93 Sawtelle Avenue; and  
Southerly at 200 Sawtelle Avenue**

**LYNN ROAD**

Request from Councilor DuBois that a “Go Slow Children” sign be installed in the vicinity of #11 and #44 Lynn Road.

**After Subcommittee review, it was determined that a “Caution Children” sign could be added on Lynn Road headed northerly in the vicinity of numbers 63 – 69.**

## **NEW BUSINESS**

### **WESTON STREET**

Request from Councilor Tom Monahan that Weston Street be restricted to resident parking only from Pleasant Street to Baxendale Avenue.

### **ENTERPRISE STREET**

Request from Councilor Chris MacMillan that the “No Parking” restriction on Enterprise Street be rescinded and the signs be removed.

### **TRAFFIC LIGHTS ON OAK STREET AT ENTRANCE TO D.W. FIELD PARK**

Request from Councilor Chris MacMillan that the Traffic Commission consider change the timing cycle of the lights or in the alternative change the lights to blinking lights in order to ease the flow of traffic on Oak Street.

### **SPRING STREET and GLENWOOD STREET**

Request from State Representative Mike Brady, on behalf of Naberge Jeanbaptiste of 140 Spring Street, that a 4-way stop sign be placed at the intersection of Spring Street and Glenwood Street.
