**OLD BUSINESS**

**TERMINAL PLACE**

Request from Councilor Paul Studenski that “No Parking” signs be re-installed on Terminal Place. The Commission will receive the report from Subcommittee after review.

**GARFIELD STREET**

Request from Councilor Paul Studenski that Garfield Street be restricted to resident only parking from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. The Commission will receive the report from Subcommittee after review.

**WINTER STREET AND NORTH CARY STREET STOP SIGN**

The Commission will receive an update from D.P.W. Commissioner Michael Thoreson on the status of traffic signals and stop signs since reconstruction was completed by the State Highway. At the previous meeting, Captain McCabe indicated that he feels that the blinking yellow light coming up Cary Street to the Fire Station should be a blinking red light, and that there should be a stop sign there. Captain McCabe stated that the original study should be reviewed again to see if the light could be changed back to red and put the Stop Sign back, and Commissioner Thoreson indicated that he would follow up on the issue and report his findings to the Commission.
