OLD BUSINESS

Belmont Street at Belmont Avenue

Request from Councilor Monahan to view the intersection of Belmont Street and Belmont Avenue to determine whether traffic lights are needed.

551 Plain Street

Request from Councilor Paul Studenski that the Traffic Commission view the area near 551 Plain Street to see if a guardrail needs to be installed as there are many accidents at that location.

Concord Street at Burton Avenue

Request from Councilor Paul Studenski that a "Caution Children" sign be added on Concord Street at Burton Avenue.

Coral Street and South Leyden Street

Request from Councilor Paul Studenski on behalf of a resident to place a 4-way stop sign at the intersection of Coral Street and South Leyden Street.

NEW BUSINESS

Hillberg Avenue and Ash Street

Request from Councilor Todd Petti on behalf of a constituent that the Traffic Commission review the intersection of Hillberg Avenue and Ash Street, as it is a dangerous intersection.

Legion Parkway

Request to review the HP sign on Legion Parkway near the beauty salon as it appears to be in a confusing location.

Lincoln Street

Request from Glenna Angelo from the Parking Authority that signs be posted on Lincoln Street restricting the parking to two hours and also that the signage on Railroad Avenue be reviewed to see if it properly addresses the allowable parking.

9 Bryant Street

Request from Councilor Dennis DeNapoli that a “Handicapped Parking” sign be placed in front on the residence of Charles MacDonald of 9 Bryant Street due to medical necessity.

522 West Chestnut Street

Request from Councilor Jass Stewart at the request of Don Boehner for regular radar patrol to enforce the speed limit on West Chestnut Street as there is a dangerous situation with cars entering and exiting the daycare driveway at this address.

West Chestnut Street

Request of Councilor Dennis Eaniri to have the Traffic Commission review the location at West Chestnut Street and Ash Street to see if additional signage can be placed there, as it is a dangerous location.

Livingston Road

Request from Councilor Jass Stewart at the request of Bernard Waithaka that parking be restricted to residents only as people are parking cars on Livingston Road and using the commuter rail and it creates a safety problem for the residents trying to exit their driveways.
