Ordered: That the sum of \$2,600,000 is hereby appropriated to pay costs of various economic development projects in the City, including (i) making extraordinary repairs to the Brockton Authority's Parking Garage located at Crescent and Main Streets, (ii) providing funds to the Brockton Redevelopment Authority to acquire and rehabilitate blighted housing units and (iii) to providing funds to Brockton 21<sup>st</sup> Century Inc., so it can make loans to small businesses and commercial real estate development projects, and for the payment of all costs incidental and related thereto; that to meet this appropriation, the City Treasurer, with the approval of the Mayor, is authorized to borrow said amount under and pursuant to Chapter 74 of the Acts of 1945, or pursuant to any other enabling authority, including but not limited to the HUD Section 108 Program of the United States of America, and to issue bonds or notes of the City therefore, and that the Mayor and the City Treasurer are authorized to execute such documents as may be necessary or desirable to carry out this transaction. 8. Order: That the City of Brockton appropriate the sum of One Hundred and Sixty Thousand (\$160,000) Dollars for conducting a feasibility study, in accordance with requirements established by the Mass School Building Authority, for roof repairs to the Raymond School Davis School; roof repairs and boiler replacements to the North Middle School roof repairs and window replacements to the Brockton High School, said sum to be expended under the direction of the Brockton School Building Committee; that the City of Brockton acknowledges that the Massachusetts School Building Authority's ("MSBA") grant program is a non-entitlement discretionary program based on need, as determined by the MSBA, and any costs the City of Brockton incurs in excess of any grant approved by and received from MSBA shall be the sole responsibility of the City of Brockton.
