4. Hearing (continued from meeting of February 15, 2012) on the request from Polish White Eagle Club of Montello, Inc. for two (2) coin-operated video skeeball machines to be added to the Automatic Amusement Device license (currently licensed for 1 Pool table).
5. Hearing on the request from Trung V. Dang dba Pho A Dong for a Common Victualer license at 379 Belmont Street.
6. Hearing on the request Tenka, Inc. dba Tenka Sushi for a Common Victualer license at 793 Crescent Street.
7. Hearing on the request from Joseph and Debra Sawaya dba Joseph Sawaya Enterprises for a Common Victualer license at 331 Oak Street. (D.W. Field Golf Snack Bar)
8. Hearing on the request from Todd Copeland dba Copeland Auto Discount to transfer the Class II License to Sell Second Hand Motor Vehicles from 1554 Main Street to 97 Manley Street.
9. Hearing (continued from meeting of February 15, 2012) on the charge brought by the local police against Todd Copeland dba Copeland Auto Discount, that the licensed used car business located at 1554 Main Street is not being operated.

10. Hearing (postponed from meeting of February 15, 2012) on the charge brought by the local police against Arcangela Lima dba M & T Auto Body, Sales and Rental, holder of a Class II Used Car Dealer license at 691-701 Montello Street, of an alleged violation of M.G.L. Chapter 140, Section 62 - failure to properly maintain a Used Car Record Book.
11. Hearing on the charge brought by the local police against Soares Club, LLC dba Bar Dino's – Lucindo Soares, Manager, 1002 Main Street, of an alleged violation of ABCC Rule 2.05(2), to wit: "No licensee for the sale of alcoholic beverages shall permit any disorder, disturbance or illegality to take place in or on the licensed premises. The licensee shall be responsible therefor, whether present or not.", reported on November 19, 2011.
12. Hearing on the charge brought by the local police against Max's Hidout, Inc. – Michael J. Asack, Manager, of an alleged violation of ABCC Rule 2.05(2), to wit: "No licensee for the sale of alcoholic beverages shall permit any disorder, disturbance or illegality to take place in or on the licensed premises. The licensee shall be responsible therefor, whether present or not.", reported on February 4, 2012.
13. Hearing on the charges brought by the local police against RJA Corporation dba Joe Angelo's Café – Carl Simmons, Manager, 216 Main and 11 Crescent Streets, of the following alleged violations reported on January 18, 2012:
  - A. **ABCC Rule 2.05(1)**, to wit: "...Gambling of any sort, except those games of chance authorized by the Legislature and/or local licensing authorities, shall not be permitted on any licensed premises."
  - B. **ABCC Rule 2.05(2)** – Permitting an illegality to take place on the licensed premises, to wit:
    - (1) **M.G.L. Chapter 140, Section 177A (5)** – Automatic Amusement Devices licensed under this section shall be so installed as to be in open view at all times while in operation, and shall at all times be available for inspection.
    - (2) **M.G.L. Chapter 140, Section 177A(6)** – No person keeping or offering for operation or allowed to be kept or offered for operation any automatic amusement device licensed under this section shall permit the same to be used for the purpose of gambling.
    - (3) Allowing unlicensed Automatic Amusement Devices on the premises
    - (4) **M.G.L. Chapter 270, Section 22** – Smoking in public places
  - C. **Brockton License Commission Rule 5**, to wit: "Gambling of any sort, except those games of chance authorized by the Legislature and local licensing authorities, shall not be permitted on any licensed premise."

- D. Brockton License Commission Rule 16**, to wit: “All licenses and building certificates shall be posted in a conspicuous place on the premises, available at all times to the proper authorities.
  - E. M.G.L. Chapter 138, Section 26** – failing to have an appointed manager as full authority and control of the premises.
