OLD BUSINESS

IRMA ROAD and RAY AVENUE

Request from Councilor Jass Stewart on behalf of resident, Karen Donovan-Chismer, who lives at 95 Irma Road. She is concerned that where Ray Avenue and Irma Road meet, the traffic doesn't slow down even though it's a T. She is looking to have "Go Slow-Children" signs placed in the area.

PLEASANT STREET BUS STOP

Request from Councilor Dennis DeNapoli:

The bus stop on Pleasant Street in front of Walgreens about 300 feet from pole # 10 West Street Capt. Williamson has contacted Ray Ledoux of BAT. Mr Ledoux is looking into the matter and will get back to Capt. Williamson shortly. Subcommittee recommends taking no action pending further information from BAT.

NEW BUSINESS

122 CHERRY STREET

Request from Captain Williamson on behalf of Pamela Wilson of 122 Cherry Street to have the Traffic Commission review the intersection of Cherry Street and Division Street as her house has been struck by automobiles several times. Mrs. Wilson is requesting that a guard rail be placed on the corner of Cherry/Division Street and also that a stop sign be installed on Cherry Street.

TREMONT STREET

Request by Captain Williamson on behalf of neighbors on Tremont Street to have "Caution Children" or "Slow" signs placed on Tremont Street between Echo Street and French Avenue. The neighbors have complained about cars and motorcycles speeding in an area where children reside.

LINCOLN STREET

Request from Councilor Dennis DeNapoli to have one hour parking signs installed on Lincoln Street. Councilor DeNapoli requested that this item be referred to Subcommittee as he will not be in attendance at the August meeting.

COBB AVENUE

Request from Councilor Dennis DeNapoli to have “No Parking” signs installed on Cobb Avenue during the Rox games and the Brockton Fair days. Councilor DeNapoli requested that this item be referred to Subcommittee as he will not be in attendance at the August meeting.

HOWARD STREET and MONTELLO STREET

Request from Councilor Dennis DeNapoli to have no turns on Howard Street at Montello Street as traffic is backing up to Winter Street; there are two lanes going north on Montello Street. Councilor DeNapoli requested that this item be referred to Subcommittee as he will not be in attendance at the August meeting.

CRESCENT STREET and LYMAN STREET

Request from Councilor Dennis DeNapoli on behalf of BAMSI (Brockton Area Multi-Services, Inc.) to take a look at the crossing signal lights (pedestrian lights) at the intersection of Crescent Street and Lyman Street.
