ORDER: That pursuant to the Massachusetts General Law, Chapter 44, Section 53E 1/2, the City Council authorizes the establishment of a revolving fund for fiscal year 2012, for the sole purposes of funding the creation and maintenance of the Abandoned Building Registry as well as the closing and boarding up of vacant and abandoned buildings. The Vacant and Abandoned Buildings Revolving Fund shall receive the receipts of payments of fines and fees for the registration of vacant and abandoned buildings. Expenditures from the Vacant and Abandoned Buildings Revolving Fund shall be made on the authority and direction of the Brockton Building Commissioner, provided that not more than seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) may be so expended from the Vacant and Abandoned Buildings Revolving Fund during fiscal year 2012. The Brockton Building Commissioner shall comply with the reporting requirements of M.G.L., Ch. 44, Section 53E ½.
