12. From the Fire Chief requesting acceptance and expenditure of \$11,325.00 from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Executive Office of Public Safety. (The Fire Department intends to use these grant funds for their Fire Safety Education Program).
13. From the Mayor in accordance with M.G.L., Ch. 44, recommending an appropriation of \$11,325.00 from Commonwealth of Massachusetts Executive Office of Public Safety, Program Division to Fire Department-Student Awareness of Fire Education (SAFE) Grant Fund to conduct Fire Education Program.
14. From the CFO in accordance with Section 5 of Ch. 324 of the Acts of 1990, certifying the proposed appropriation of \$11,325.00 from Commonwealth of

From the Mayor in accordance with M.G.L., Ch. 44 recommending that the City Council authorize the appropriation of \$222,000 from Stabilization Fund to Department of Public Works Operations Division Highway-Street Lighting Account. The purpose of this appropriation is to fund the balance needed for the FY2013 DPW Highway Section Street Lighting Account's remaining FY13 maintenance fees and electricity costs.
23. From the CFO in accordance with Section 5 of Chapter 324 of the Acts of 1990, certifying to support the proposed appropriation of \$222,000 from Stabilization Fund to DPW Highway Section Street Light Acct.
