### **OLD BUSINESS**

#### **SUMMER STREET at EDSON STREET**

Request from Councilor Paul Studenski to have the Traffic Commission review the intersection of Summer Street and Edson Street with a view towards making this a safer intersection.

Subcommittee recommends making a 3 way stop intersection. We will add two more stop signs - 1 for southbound traffic on Summer Street at Edson St (on the corner); and 1 for eastbound traffic on Summer Street across from the above corner. (Also, check on the approval of the stop sign that is currently at the corner on Edson Street at Summer Street.)

#### **BRIDGE OVERPASSES at COURT STREET, CENTRE STREET and CRESCENT STREET**

Subcommittee recommends putting up signs that state "Underpass ahead – clearance \_\_\_ Ft. \_\_\_ In."

Heading East - 1 on Crescent Street - near Maple Ave - 15'6" clearance  
1 on Centre St - near WB Mason - 14' clearance  
1 on Court St - just east of Main St at the top of the hill - 13'6" clearance

Heading West - 1 on Court St - just east of the river 13'6" clearance  
1 on Centre St - just east of the river 14' clearance

1 on Crescent St - just east of the river

### **BROOKSIDE AVENUE**

Request from Councilor Paul Studenski at the request of residents to have the Traffic Commission re-review the parking restrictions on Brookside Avenue.

Subcommittee recommendation: To take no further action and leave the restriction as is.

Ken Galligan stated that he was of the understanding that the Commission was waiting for a report from Commissioner Thoreson on the gas line on Brookside Avenue. He stated that Commissioner Thoreson was supposed to contact the gas company and have them show the Commission where the gas line was and requested that the matter be continued to the next month's agenda awaiting the Commissioner's report. (Matter continued to the next meeting until Commissioner Thoreson's report is received.)

### **NEW BUSINESS**

#### **ADDISON STREET**

Request from Councilor Shirley Asack on behalf of residents to have the Traffic Commission address the issue of truck parking on Addison Street and to discuss restricting parking and traveling on that street so that commercial vehicles are not allowed.

#### **HOLBROOK AVENUE**

Request from Councilor Jass Stewart on behalf of a resident regarding too many cars parked on the street and blocking traffic on Holbrook Avenue. Councilor Stewart would like the Commission to consider restricting parking to one side of the street.
