OLD BUSINESS

WESTGATE DRIVE

Request from Councilor Shirley Asack on behalf of Harry Minassian, Sr. to have more signage placed on Westgate Drive in the vicinity of Westgate Lanes as there is a speeding problem there.

CHANNING AVENUE and LONGWOOD AVENUE

Request from Councilor Dennis Eaniri that a street sign be placed on the telephone pole at the corner of Longwood Avenue and Channing Avenue identifying Channing Avenue. The sign from Longwood Ave is missing. The street is identified from Wilson Street only.

201 NEWBURY STREET

Request from Councilor Thomas Monahan on behalf of resident Dorothy Hearn to have an "Autistic Child" sign placed in front of her home at 201 Newbury Street.

RAINBOW CIRCLE

Request from Councilor Shirley Asack to have the Traffic Commission view the area of Rainbow Circle as there are speeding problems on this street.

59 RAINBOW CIRCLE

Request from Councilor Shirley Asack on behalf of Smith Vil to have an "Autistic Child" sign installed in front of 59 Rainbow Circle.

46 RIVER STREET

Request from Councilor Dennis DeNapoli on behalf of Steven License to have a "No Parking" sign installed in front of his resident at 46 River Street.

PEARL STREET

Request from Councilor Tim Cruise on behalf of Tom Sedell to have the Traffic Commission review the area on Pearl Street headed northbound at Pleasant Street to determine whether the left-turn only lane should be made a dual left-turn or straight ahead lane.

NEW BUSINESS

WILLARD AVENUE at PINE STREET

Request from Ken Galligan to have a Stop Sign installed on Willard Avenue at Pine Street.

Requests from Councilor Michelle Dubois:

Where Amark Road becomes Coe Rd & intersects with Dagmar Drive.

Placement of 2 new Stop Signs on Amark Road and Coe Road at their intersection with Dagmar Drive. There is currently a stop sign on Dagmar Drive but we would like to make this intersection a four-way stop. Re-paint crosswalk at the end of Dagmar Drive.

On Amark Road and Coe Road:

Installation of speed limit signs and "Slow Children" signs along Amark Road and Coe Road.

Speeding Ticket Traps on Coe Road:

We request increased traffic patrols on issuing of tickets on Coe Road. Parents going to and from the Ashfield School speed on Coe Road. We are very lucky that there has not been a serious accident yet as there are no sidewalks on Coe Road and children walk home in the street.

On East Ashland St, at intersection with Colgate Road & Algonquin St:

East Ashland Street: Re-paint crosswalk going across East Ashland Street from Colgate Road and Algonquin Streets. Re-painting of crosswalk with more visible paint (fluorescence in color, solid or striped). Examples follow:



East Ashland Street at Colgate & Algonquin:

Placement of a Cross Walk Sign on either side of the crosswalk, as shown below:



East Ashland Street at Colgate & Algonquin: Placement of "Crosswalk sign ahead" 25 feet and 50 feet from this cross walk in either direction on East Ashland Street. Example below:



East Ashland Street: Placement of a yellow, plastic crosswalk sign on East Ashland Street. I am happy to pay for the sign and have pasted a picture of the sign types:



East Ashland Street at Colgate & Algonquin: Paint STOP on the Street.
