ORDERS:

20. Ordered: That the Brockton City Council does hereby grant a perpetual right and easement to Massachusetts Electric Company, and Verizon New England, Inc., for consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) to construct, reconstruct, repair, maintain, operate and patrol, for the transmission of high and low voltage electric current and for the transmission of intelligence and telephone use, lines to consist of, but not limited to, one (1) pole with wires and cable installed thereon, and all necessary foundations, anchors, guys, braces, fittings, equipment and appurtenances over, across, under and upon land owned by the City of Brockton being located on the southerly side of North Cary Street. And further, that the City Council authorizes the Mayor to execute the "Grant of Easement" and to take any actions necessary to carry out the terms, purposes and conditions of the same.
