### **OLD BUSINESS**

#### **MORaine STREET, SYCAMORE STREET, SPRING STREET**

Request from Councilor Tim Cruise to place "No Parking" signs on Sycamore Street, Moraine Street, and Spring Street, based on numerous complaints by neighbors.

*Subcommittee recommends installing "No Parking Between Signs" signs on pole #15 and pole #16 on Moraine Street.*

#### **AMES STREET and NORTH MONTELLO STREET**

Requests from Councilor Michelle Dubois:

1. To place a no right turn for big trucks (18-wheeler etc) at Ames Street and North Montello Street. The right turn to be limited only for trucks on Ames Street, exiting the village area, and turning right onto North Montello Street; and
2. That a guard rail be placed at the corner of Ames Street and North Montello Street, in front of the Vulcan Bar.

*Subcommittee recommends installing a "Truck Route" sign on the northeast corner of Ames Street and Spark Street (across from #97 Ames Street) with an arrow pointing right, directing trucks to go north on Spark Street.*

#### **HOLBROOK AVENUE**

Request from Councilor Shirley Asack to restrict parking to residents only as they have had parking issues.

*Subcommittee recommends taking no action.*

#### **CLARENCE STREET and ALBION STREET**

Request from Councilor Shirley Asack to have a Stop Sign placed at the intersection of Clarence Street and Albion Street (at the Montello Stop 'N Shop entrance), as there currently is no stop sign there.

*Subcommittee recommends taking no action.*

### **FAIRMOUNT AVENUE and DIVISION STREET**

Request from Councilor Shirley Asack on behalf of resident Jessica Deburgo of 4 Fairmount Avenue to have the Traffic Commission review the 4 way intersection of Fairmount Avenue and Division Street. There is only a stop at Fairmount Avenue.

*Subcommittee recommends taking no action on this matter. Subcommittee members further request that Councilor Asack reach out to the owner of the property at 50-52 Fairmount Avenue.*

### **BELLEVUE CIRCLE, BELLEVUE AVENUE and BALTIC AVENUE**

Request from Deputy Fire Chief Kevin Galligan to have the Traffic Commission review Bellevue Circle & Bellevue Avenue & Baltic Avenue for a possible stop sign.

*Subcommittee recommends installing a new "Stop" sign with a red stripe on the Baltic Avenue sign in front of #4, stopping northbound traffic on Baltic Avenue.*

### **NORTH MAIN STREET**

Request from Councilor Shirley Asack to have signs placed on North Main Street in the vicinity of the fire station restricting parking on the east side of the street, in order to allow the fire apparatus to exit and enter the fire station.

*Subcommittee recommends replacing the current "No Parking" signs with larger signs and painting hash marks in the fog line the next time painting is scheduled.*

## **NEW BUSINESS**

### **THOMPSON AVENUE**

Request from Councilor Shirley Asack on behalf of David Cruise to have street signage installed on Thompson Avenue.

### **LAWRENCE STREET and MONTELLO STREET**

Request from Councilor Dennis DeNapoli on behalf of resident, Mrs. O'Connor, to have the Traffic Commission have a pedestrian signal installed at the lights at the intersection of Lawrence Street and Montello Street.

### **920 CRESCENT STREET**

Request from Councilor Dennis DeNapoli on behalf of resident Elaine Herman of 920 Crescent Street to have an "Autistic Child" sign installed at 920 Crescent Street (at the corner of Hall Street).

### **HOMESITE ROAD**

Request from Officer William Healy to place 2 signs on Homesite Road that read the following:

"No Overnight Parking (12pm - 7AM) From Here to Corner". This sign would be posted in front of 43 Homesite. As you drive west on Homesite you would view the sign restriction.

"No Overnight Parking (12pm - 7AM)". This sign would be affixed on utility pole #4 which is located between 40 and 50 Homesite. As you drive east on Homesite you would view the sign restriction.

### **FOREST STREET**

Request from Councilor Paul Studenski at the request of a resident to have "Caution – Children" signs installed on Forest Street as there have been issues with speeding on the street.

### **OAK HILL WAY**

Request from Councilor Paul Studenski on behalf of UPS to have signage and a crosswalk installed on Oak Hill Way in the vicinity of the UPS facility.

### **PACKARD STREET and MAIN STREET**

Request from Officer Antonio Randolph to have Stop Signs installed at Packard Street and Main Street.

### **FLORENCE STREET and MAIN STREET**

Request from Officer Antonio Randolph to have Stop Signs installed at Florence Street and Main Street.

### **WINTER STREET**

Request from Councilor DuBois on behalf of a City resident that crosswalks be painted and cross walk warning signs be installed at the following Winter Street intersections. The request is for the crosswalks to go over Winter Street so children can get from one side of this incredibly busy street to the other in a safe manner. At a minimum one of the top three locations must be installed.

1. Winter at the intersection with Bourne Street,
2. Winter at the intersection with Keswick Road
3. Winter at the intersection with Field Street
4. Winter at the intersection with Hermon Street.
5. Winter at the intersection with Lawton Ave.
6. Winter at Sheldon OR Andover Street.

### **FOREST AVENUE and BOUVE AVENUE – TRAFFIC SIGNALS**

Request from Deputy Fire Chief Kevin Galligan to have the Traffic Commission members address the issue of problems with the traffic signals at Forest Avenue and Bouve Avenue, as well as other city locations.

### **HILLSIDE AVENUE and SNELL STREET**

Request from Captain DiBari to have the Traffic Commission vote to place a 4-way Stop sign at Hillside Avenue and Snell Street.
