### **OLD BUSINESS**

#### **NORTH MAIN STREET CRIME WATCH SIGNS**

Request from Officer Bill Healy on behalf of the Montello Business Association to have Crime Watch signs placed at the following locations on North Main Street:

##### **Heading north on North Main Street**

Utility pole #41 in front of 553 N. Main St (the Ruth House)

Utility pole #60 at Broad and N. Main Streets (across from #704)

##### **Heading south on North Main Street**

On traffic light pole in front of 686 N. Main Street (Catholic Charities)

Utility pole #4884 in front of 610 N. Main Street (JJ's Café)

#### **129 AMES STREET**

Request from Councilor Shaynah Barnes on behalf of resident Seriano Cruz to have a "Blind Driveway" sign placed at his home at 129 Ames Street, as he lives on the curve of Ames Street and cars speed around that corner and he has difficulty exiting and entering his driveway.

#### **CENTRE STREET**

Request from Captain DiBari to have a speed limit sign placed on Centre Street east bound, just prior to the intersection of Plymouth Street.

#### **85 FORD STREET**

Request from Councilor Shirley Asack on behalf of Joel Robbins to have a "Handicapped Parking Only" sign placed in front of his residence at 85 Ford Street.

## NEW BUSINESS

### JONATHAN DRIVE

Request From Councilor Dennis Eaniri to have **“No Parking” signs** installed on one side of Jonathan Drive (located off Manley Street), with the Traffic Commission Subcommittee to determine which side.

### PROSPECT STREET

Request from Captain DiBari on behalf of Officer Smith to have **“No Parking” signs** placed on Prospect Street from North Main St to the first house on the right side of the street.

### NORTH CARY STREET

Request from Councilor Dennis DeNapoli on behalf of Jonathan Slawsby, an owner of the Save-A-Lot on East Ashland Street. They have had complaints from neighbors about trucks idling on North Cary Street while waiting to get into our receiving yard. They would like to have **“No Stopping” signs** installed to help alleviate the situation, as it is both an annoyance for the residents and a safety hazard. They would pay for the signs.

### SHERIDAN STREET and BENHAM STREET

Request from Ollie Spears to have **“Stop” signs** installed heading north and south on Sheridan Street at the intersection with Benham Street.
