#### OLD BUSINESS

##### HILLSIDE AVENUE and SNELL AVENUE

Request from Councilor Paul Studenski on behalf Bob DiCarlo of 91 Hillside Avenue to have a Stop Sign installed on Snell Avenue at the intersection with Hillside Avenue thereby creating a 4-way stop. Mr. DiCarlo presented a petition signed by 26 residents.

**Subcommittee recommendation: - After having the traffic officers look into this intersection, it was determined that there is no need for a 4 way stop here.**

##### MAIN STREET and SCHOOL STREET

Request from Councilor Shaynah Barnes to have "One Way" signs installed at the intersection of School Street and Main Street, to prevent drivers from taking a right turn from Main Street and proceeding east on School Street over the one-way portion of the street until they reach the 2-way section of the street.

**Subcommittee recommendation: Install a one way arrow sign on the existing post closer to Main Street pointing west.**

##### HILL STREET at CRESCENT STREET

Request from Councilor Moises Rodrigues on behalf of resident Billy Joe Williams, to have a crosswalk installed at the corner of Hill Street and Crescent Street.

**Subcommittee recommendation: Install a cross walk on the northwest corner of Hill Street at pole # 65 across Crescent Street.**

##### PROTENTIS PLAZA – 156-162 MAIN STREET

Request from Councilor Dennis DeNapoli on behalf of Paul Protentis to have a 15 minute loading zone area established either on Main Street or East Elm Street.

**Subcommittee recommendation: Table this item to get more information on what size trucks will be making deliveries.**

### **JONATHAN DRIVE**

Request From Councilor Dennis Eaniri to have “No Parking” signs installed on one side of Jonathan Drive (located off Manley St.), with the Traffic Commission Subcommittee to determine which side. This matter was referred from the April meeting in order for Captain DiBari, Councilor Eaniri and D.P.W. Commissioner Larry Rowley to meet with the businesses and come back with recommendations.

### **NORTH CARY STREET**

Request from Councilor Dennis DeNapoli on behalf of Jonathan Slawsby, an owner of Save-A-Lot on East Ashland Street. This matter was referred from the April meeting to see how management has handled the issue.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

### **LINCOLN STREET and WEST RAILROAD AVENUE**

Request from Ken Galligan to have the “No Parking” signs which were installed prior to reconstruction of this area replaced. This is a public safety issue to allow for sufficient turning radius for fire trucks for that location.

**Subcommittee Recommendation: Place 2 “NO PARKING” signs on the east side of W. Railroad Ave at the corner. There were signs there before so we are just replacing them.**
