OLD BUSINESS

COURT STREET

Request from Councilor Shaynah Barnes on behalf of residents on Court Street to have the Traffic Commission view the portion of Court Street from North Quincy Street to the Abington line to determine what signage can be placed there to slow the cars that are speeding now that the road has been repaved.

CORNELL STREET and RUTH ROAD

Request from Ollie Spears to have a Stop Sign installed at Cornell Street and Ruth Road, north to south.

WEST ELM TERRACE

Request to have the Traffic Commission replace a gate at the end of West Elm Terrace, which is a legal dead end street, as the street is unsafe for children to play on due to the amount of high rate speeding and traffic coming down the street.

PROTENTIS PLAZA – 156-162 MAIN STREET

Request from Councilor Dennis DeNapoli on behalf of Paul Protentis to have a 15 minute loading zone area established either on Main Street or East Elm Street. This was continued from the May and July meetings to get more information on what size trucks will be making deliveries. Captain DiBari stated that no new information has been received at this time and that he will contact Councilor DeNapoli.
