OLD BUSINESS

CONNELL AVENUE and RUTH ROAD

Request from Ollie Spears to have a Stop Sign installed at Connell Avenue and Ruth Road, north to south.

Subcommittee Recommendation: Recommend we do nothing to the stop signs and Captain DiBari will have the traffic unit assigned there for a while during the rush hours.

1104 MAIN STREET

Request from Councilor Paul Studenski to have a "Handicapped Parking Only" spot designated in front of the United States Post Office at 1104 Main Street.

Subcommittee Recommendation: Place the Handicap sign on Main Street just north of the entrance to 1090 Main Street.

CALMAR STREET

Request from Ken Galligan to have "One Way" signs installed on Calmar Street: one sign at Denton Street, and one sign across from the exit from the parking lot of Cape Cod Café.

Subcommittee Recommendation: Place 1 "One Way" sign on pole #1 facing west; 1 "One Way" sign on the north side of the street up against the building; and 1 "One Way" sign on Pole 1-2 on the corner of Denton Street.

RICHMOND STREET at BATTLES STREET

Review this location to determine exact placement of the Stop signs that were previously approved by the Traffic Commission for this location.

Subcommittee Recommendation: Place the Stop Sign with a red stripe at the corner of Richmond Street at Neal Street.

PLAIN STREET at DAVIS SCHOOL

Request from Lt. Donald Mills of the School Police to have "No Parking" signs installed on Plain Street, on the north side of the street by the western most exit of the Davis school. During dismissal, vehicles will park there obstructing the view of traffic for exiting motorists.

Subcommittee Recommendation: Place "No Parking" signs on north side of the street by the western most exit on both sides of the exit.

NEW BUSINESS

1104 MAIN STREET

Request from Councilor Paul Studenski to have a “Handicapped Parking Only” spot designated in front of the United States Post Office at 1104 Main Street.

MOUNT MORIAH BAPTIST CHURCH

Request from Councilor Shaynah Barnes on behalf of the membership at Mount Moriah Baptist Church, 24 Pleasant Street, to have a crosswalk installed in front of their church as there is a public safety issue with residents trying to cross the street.

55 BYRON AVENUE

Request from Captain DiBari on behalf of resident Francine Nicholson, who has requested a Handicap Parking sign placed in front of her house at 55 Byron Avenue.

GREEN STREET at NEWBURY STREET

Request from Councilor Thomas Monahan on behalf of resident Denise Renaud of 52 Newbury Street to have 4-way Stop Signs installed at Green Street and Newbury Street.

JONATHAN DRIVE

Request from Councilor Dennis Eaniri on behalf of Dan Blackler of GTR Manufacturing of 1 Jonathan Drive to have “No Parking” signs installed on Jonathan Drive as cars parking on the roadway are making the road too narrow and blocking entrances to their parking lot.

WEST CHESTNUT STREET at DONALD STREET

Request From Councilor Dennis Eaniri to have the Traffic Commission review the traffic situation at West Chestnut Street at Donald Street where the one-way section of West Chestnut Street becomes two-way traffic and cars coming up West Chestnut Street are traveling at a fast rate of speed.

WEST CHESTNUT STREET at LINWOOD STREET

Request from Councilor Dennis Eaniri to have the Traffic Commission review the traffic issue in the area of Linwood Street as residents are complaining that it is difficult to get out of their driveways as cars are going faster than the posted speed limit.

OAK STREET at CAMPANELLI INDUSTRIAL DRIVE

Request from Councilor Shirley Asack on behalf of resident Linda Spiegel of 27 Madrid Square to have a “No Turn On Red” sign installed on Oak Street across from Campanelli Industrial Drive.

WILDER STREET EXTENSION at NORTH MONTELLO STREET

Request from Councilor Shirley Asack on behalf of resident Amy Costan to have a Stop Sign installed on Wilder Street Extension at North Montello Street.
