815 MAIN STREET

Request from Councilor Paul Studenski to have a Handicapped Parking spot placed in front of 815 Main Street.

46 RIVER STREET

Request from Councilor Dennis DeNapoli on behalf of resident Mary License to have a "Do Not Block Driveway" sign installed in front of 46 River Street as the resident has an elderly father and a husband who is very ill and they have problems with the driveway being blocked.

NEWTON STREET

Request from Councilor Tom Monahan on behalf of Pat Kelliher to have the one-way traffic on Newton Street reviewed to possibly make it a two-way street.

WEST CHESTNUT STREET at DONALD STREET

Request from Councilor Dennis Eaniri to have the Traffic Commission review the traffic situation at West Chestnut Street at Donald Street where the one-way section of West Chestnut Street becomes two-way traffic and cars coming up West Chestnut Street are traveling at a fast rate of speed.

WEST CHESTNUT STREET and MERCEDES ROAD

Request from Councilor Dennis Eaniri to have a guardrail installed at West Chestnut Street and Mercedes Road.

629 PLEASANT STREET

Request from Councilor Shirley Asack on behalf of Attorney John McCluskey, representing Brad Cartwright, to review the project for a retail and restaurant use at 629 Pleasant Street.

WAITT FUNERAL HOME – 850 NORTH MAIN STREET

Request from Councilor Shirley Asack on behalf of Greg Belcher of Waitt Funeral Home, 850 North Main Street, to review the signage and traffic issues as there are continuing problems.

OAK STREET and RESERVOIR STREET

Request from Councilor Shirley Asack on behalf of some residents to have a pedestrian crossing button installed on the traffic signal at Oak Street and Reservoir Street.

BATES ROAD and GLOUCESTER STREET

Request from Councilor Paul Studenski to have 4-way stop signs installed at Bates Road and Gloucester Street.

NEW BUSINESS

869 MAIN STREET

Request from Councilor Paul Studenski on behalf of Austin Ahanon to have an HP parking space installed in front of 869 Main Street.

CENTRE STREET

Request from Robert Malley, Executive Director of the Brockton Parking Authority, to change the parking regulations governing the south side of Centre Street from Montello Street to Main Street, to remove the parking meters and make this block parking by permit only.

BELMONT STREET

Request from Councilor Shaynah Barnes to have additional signage placed on Belmont Street between Main Street and Warren Avenue to alert drivers that this portion of the roadway is one-way.

CHESTER AVENUE

Request from Councilor Tom Monahan on behalf of Conley Funeral Home to have the Traffic Commission review the parking on Chester Avenue as cars are parking too close to the entrance/exit driveway on Chester Avenue, making it difficult to exit the parking lot.

CHRISTY'S DRIVE

Request from Councilor Tim Cruise on behalf of BAMS I that a pedestrian crosswalk be installed between #10 and #15 Christy's Drive.

MAIN STREET

Request from Robert Malley, Brockton Parking Authority, to have the Traffic Commission members review the signage on Main Street between White Avenue and Pleasant Street, in order to clarify and simplify the parking restrictions in that area.
