OLD BUSINESS

472 NORTH QUINCY STREET

Request from Councilor Jack Lally on behalf of the resident at 472 North Quincy Street that a guardrail be placed in front of this residence as it is at the intersection with North Cary Street and there are many accidents at this location and some cars are going onto this property.

Subcommittee Recommendation: We will get a price for an 18 foot guardrail and make further determination once the cost is known. Continued from July meeting.

MAIN STREET

Request from Robert Malley, Brockton Parking Authority, to have the Traffic Commission members review the signage on Main Street between White Avenue and Pleasant Street, in order to clarify and simplify the parking restrictions in that area. Voted to continue this matter to the August meeting for further information from the Department of Public Works. Continued from the July meeting.

HIGHLAND STREET

Request from Councilor Tom Monahan on behalf of resident Alvin Davis to have "No Parking" signs placed on the even-numbered side of Highway Street from Lexington Street to Spring Street as there is a parking problem there.

Subcommittee Recommendation: Leave the parking situation as is.

441 MAIN STREET

Request from Councilor Paul Studenski and Councilor Shaynah Barnes on behalf of the Full Gospel Tabernacle Church, 441 Main Street to have the "No Parking" signs that were recently installed removed from in front of the church.

Subcommittee Recommendation: Leave the "No Parking" sign there as it is a safety issue for the crosswalk.

EAST CHESTNUT STREET and MONTELLO STREET

Request from Ken Galligan to place “No Parking Here to Corner” signs on the south side of East Chestnut Street for thirty feet (30’) westerly from Montello Street.

Subcommittee Recommendation: Place the No Parking signs as stated..

WEST ELM STREET

Request from D.P.W. Commissioner Larry Rowley to have “No Parking” signs installed on both sides of West Elm Street from Warren Avenue to West Street as bike lanes with a five foot (5’) minimum are being installed on West Elm Street.

Subcommittee Recommendation: Continue this topic until we can look at the plans and have more discussion.

SCHOOL STREET

Request from Rob May, Director of Planning to have two (2) food trucks park on the south side of School Street between Main Street and the alley way where the dumpster is located.

Subcommittee Recommendation: We can allow 1 food truck on School St just west of the crosswalk in front of 34 School St and east of the driveway to City Hall.

NORTH MONTELLO STREET at WILMINGTON STREET

Request from Councilor Shirley Asack on behalf of Marilyn Van Brunt to have four way Stop signs installed at North Montello Street and Wilmington Street at the exit to the commuter rail parking lot.

Subcommittee Recommendation: Replace the faded stop sign for westbound traffic on Wilmington St and replace the "No Parking" signs that have been removed.

17 THOMAS CIRCLE

Request from Councilor Farwell to place a “Blind Child” sign in the neighborhood of 17 Thomas Circle (Meghan Carlino) as her child is legally blind.

Subcommittee Recommendation: Upon proper documentation, place the "Blind Child" sign on pole 1 in front of 9 Thomas Cir.

629 PLEASANT STREET

Request from Councilor Shirley Asack on behalf of Attorney John McCluskey, representing Brad Cartwright, to review the project for a retail and restaurant use at 629 Pleasant Street. **Continued from the January meeting.**

The applicant has made substantial changes to the project. The size of the proposed building has been reduced by approximately 25% and access to and from Pennsylvania Avenue has been eliminated.
