OLD BUSINESS

MAIN STREET

Request from Robert Malley, Brockton Parking Authority, to have the Traffic Commission members review the signage on Main Street between White Avenue and Pleasant Street, in order to clarify and simplify the parking restrictions in that area. Continued from the August meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

KENWOOD STREET

Request from Councilor Studenski to address the parking situation on Kenwood Street. At one point there were "No Parking" signs located on the street. They are no longer there.

BATES ROAD

Request from the Mayor on behalf of resident Sarah Mathena to have a stop sign at the main 4-way intersection at Bates Road and Gloucester Street.

PAYTON COURT

Request from Councilor Shirley Asack on behalf of resident Jilleen Morgan of Payton Court for traffic committee to relook at Battles Street no parking both sides of Street and to restrict large vehicles from using Battles Street / make it a no truck route.

AUGUSTINE STREET
