OLD BUSINESS

MAIN STREET

Request from Robert Malley, Brockton Parking Authority, to have the Traffic Commission members review the signage on Main Street between White Avenue and Pleasant Street, in order to clarify and simplify the parking restrictions in that area. Continued from the September meeting.

KENWOOD STREET

Request from Councilor Studenski to address the parking situation on Kenwood Street. At one point there were "No Parking" signs located on the street. They are no longer there.

Subcommittee Recommendation: Continue to the next meeting

BATES ROAD

Request from the Mayor on behalf of resident Sarah Mathena to have a stop sign at the main 4-way intersection at Bates Road and Gloucester Street.

Subcommittee Recommendation: Place one 30 MPH sign on pole # 16 for southbound traffic and one across from # 56 Bates Road for northbound traffic

PAYTON COURT

Request from Councilor Shirley Asack on behalf of resident Jilleen Morgan of Payton Court for traffic committee to relook at Battles Street no parking both sides of Street and to restrict large vehicles from using Battles Street / make it a no truck route.

Subcommittee Recommendation: Leave as is.

AUGUSTINE STREET

Request from Councilor Shirley Asack on behalf of Gerald Maloney of Augustine Street to have committee review parking from north main end of Augustine Street as many times residents have a problem exiting their drive way

NEW BUSINESS

JON DRIVE/NORTH QUINCY STREET

Request from Councilor Lally to have the current school sign that is located on Jon Drive/North Quincy Street removed and replaced with a bigger "School" sign.

ROCKLAND STREET

Request from Councilor Winthrop Farwell on behalf of the Forrester Family at 71 Rockland Street to have a "Caution- Autistic Child" sign placed on Rockland Street visible in both directions.

BELAIR STREET
