ORDINANCE:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART II OF THE REVISED
ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BROCKTON.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Brockton as follows:

Time limit on issuance: Permits issued from the inspector of poles and wires will be held no longer than six (6) months, after which time, a new application will have to be taken out.

Additional fees: An additional charge of sixty [dollars] (\$60.00) shall be made and paid for by the electrician doing the work for additional inspection resulting in the opinion of the inspector of poles and wires from defective work, improper mechanical execution of electrical work, job not completed, improper information on application and wrong address, and twice amount will be levied for failure to take out a permit.
