

MINUTES  
PARK COMMISSION  
MEETING OF THURSDAY, DECEMBER 11TH, 2014

The Park Commission held its monthly meeting at 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 11th, 2014 at their office located at 45 Meadow Lane, Brockton, MA. There being a proper quorum, the meeting was called to order by Chairman Harold Marrow. Present were Commissioners Billy Anderson, Chickie Studenski, Bill Keane, Chris Connolly and Superintendent Timothy W. Carpenter.

Superintendent Carpenter reported on D.W. Field Golf Course. He stated that the revenues for November were \$20,358. In November, 2013 revenues were \$17,988. The 14 year average is approximately \$28,005. Ten days were loss due to inclement weather. The Year to Date revenue for the season is at \$695,669. The total revenue of last Golf Season was \$643,784. He stated that if the numbers hold from last year the golf course should reach the forecasted total revenues. He reported that at this time, there will be less cleanup and more maintenance performed at the Golf Course. Tree work will be done by both employees and outside contractors. Included in the scheduled winter maintenance, he hopes to take out the lockers and add more tables.

Superintendent Carpenter reported that the Park employee are directing their winter efforts on repair of fences, bringing in the volleyball and tennis nets and general maintenance of vehicles and equipment and should start significant tree work next month.

Superintendent Carpenter updated the Commission on the Mulberry Street Playground. The contractor has completed the binder coat for the Basketball Court and Parking Lot. The play equipment is scheduled to be installed next week. As for the City Hall Plaza Project, the concrete work is coming along slowly because of the weather conditions.

Superintendent Carpenter stated the upcoming FY16 Budget will be prepared by February.

Superintendent Carpenter forwarded information pertaining to the revision of Permit Application Guidelines and Procedures; and fee schedule for Golf and Park rates to be discussed and voted on at the January, 2015 meeting.

Having no further business, a motion was made by Commissioner Studenski and seconded by Commissioner Connolly to adjourn the meeting at 7:42PM.
