**MINUTES**

The Traffic Commission held its regular monthly meeting at 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 25, 2016 at the Brockton Police Station, 7 Commercial Street, Brockton, MA 02302.

Present were Traffic Commissioners: Captain Robert DiBari, DPW Commissioner Larry Rowley, Ret. Chief Kenneth Galligan, Councilor Shirley Asack and Craig Pina.

There being a proper quorum, the meeting was called to order by Captain DiBari. Upon motion made by Kenneth Galligan, seconded by Craig Pina, and a unanimous vote of all members present, it was voted to waive the reading of the July Minutes.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

#### **472 NORTH QUINCY STREET**

*Request from Councilor Jack Lally on behalf of the resident at 472 North Quincy Street that a guardrail be placed in front of this residence as it is at the intersection with North Cary Street and there are many accidents at this location and some cars are going onto this property.*

Discussion: We will get the accident records for this location and try to find the funding for it.

Upon motion duly made by Kenneth Galligan, seconded by Craig Pina, and a Unanimous vote of the members present, it was

**VOTED:** Support the placing of the guardrail and arrow sign.

#### **MAIN STREET**

*Request from Robert Malley, Brockton Parking Authority, to have the Traffic Commission members review the signage on Main Street between White Avenue and Pleasant Street, in order to clarify and simplify the parking restrictions in that area.*

Upon motion duly made by Councilor Asack, seconded by Larry Rowley, and a unanimous vote of the members present, it was

**VOTED:** Continue the matter to the September meeting. The City has not accepted the work yet.

### **HIGHLAND STREET**

*Request from Councilor Tom Monahan on behalf of resident Alvin Davis to have “No Parking” signs placed on the even-numbered side of Highland Street from Lexington Street to Spring Street as there is a parking problem there.*

Upon motion duly made by Craig Pina, seconded by Councilor Asack, and a unanimous vote of the members present, it was

**VOTED:** Accept the subcommittee recommendations.

### **441 MAIN STREET**

*Request from Councilor Paul Studenski and Councilor Shaynah Barnes on behalf of the Full Gospel Tabernacle Church, 441 Main Street to have the “No Parking” signs that were recently installed removed from in front of the church.*

Upon motion duly made by Councilor Asack, seconded by Craig Pina, and a unanimous vote of the members present, it was

**VOTED:** Accept the subcommittee recommendations.

### **EAST CHESTNUT STREET and MONTELLO STREET**

*Request from Ken Galligan to place “No Parking Here to Corner” signs on the south side of East Chestnut Street for thirty feet (30’) westerly from Montello Street.*

Upon motion duly made by Kenneth Galligan, seconded by Councilor Asack, and a Unanimous vote of the members present, it was

**VOTED:** Accept the subcommittee recommendations.

### **WEST ELM STREET**

*Request from D.P.W. Commissioner Larry Rowley to have “No Parking” signs installed on both sides of West Elm Street from Warren Avenue to West Street as bike lanes with a five foot (5’) minimum are being installed on West Elm Street.*

Discussion: Motion was made to place the No Parking signs.

Upon motion duly made by Councilor Asack, seconded by Craig Pina, and a unanimous vote of the members present, it was

**VOTED:** Place the No Parking Signs as requested.

### **SCHOOL STREET**

*Request from Rob May, Director of Planning to have two (2) food trucks park on the south side of School Street between Main Street and the alley way where the dumpster is located.*

Upon motion duly made by Craig Pina, seconded by Larry Rowley, and a unanimous vote of the members present, it was

**VOTED:** Accept the subcommittee recommendations.

### **NORTH MONTELLO STREET at WILMINGTON STREET**

*Request from Councilor Shirley Asack on behalf of Marilyn Van Brunt to have four way Stop signs installed at North Montello Street and Wilmington Street at the exit to the commuter rail parking lot.*

Upon motion duly made by Larry Rowley, seconded by Ken Galligan, and a Unanimous vote of the members present, it was

**VOTED:** Accept the subcommittee recommendations.

### **17 THOMAS CIRCLE**

*Request from Councilor Farwell to place a "Blind Child" sign in the neighborhood of 17 Thomas Circle (Meghan Carlino) as her child is legally blind.*

Upon motion duly made by Kenneth Galligan, seconded by Larry Rowley, and a unanimous vote of the members present, it was

**VOTED:** Accept the subcommittee recommendations.
