**MINUTES**

The Traffic Commission held its regular monthly meeting at 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 22, 2016 at the Brockton Police Station, 7 Commercial Street, Brockton, MA 02302.

Present were Traffic Commissioners: Captain Robert DiBari, DPW Commissioner Larry Rowley, Ret. Chief Kenneth Galligan, Morton Schleffer and Councilor Shirley Asack. Also present was Councilor Paul Studenski.

There being a proper quorum, the meeting was called to order by Captain DiBari. Upon motion made by Kenneth Galligan, seconded by Morton Schleffer, and a unanimous vote of all members present, it was voted to waive the reading of the August Minutes.

### **MAIN STREET**

*Request from Robert Malley, Brockton Parking Authority, to have the Traffic Commission members review the signage on Main Street between White Avenue and Pleasant Street, in order to clarify and simplify the parking restrictions in that area.*

Upon motion duly made by Kenneth Galligan, seconded by Councilor Shirley Asack, and a unanimous vote of the members present, it was

### **NEW BUSINESS**

#### **KENWOOD STREET**

*Request from Councilor Studenski to address the parking situation on Kenwood Street. At one point there were "No Parking" signs located on the street. They are no longer there.*

Discussion: Check to see if there was restricted parking in the past and if so, replace the missing signs. If there was never restricted parking place "No Parking" signs on the east side of the street from Brookside Avenue to Glenn Avenue.

## **PAYTON COURT**

*Request from Councilor Shirley Asack on behalf of resident Jilleen Morgan of Payton Court for traffic committee to relook at Battles Street no parking both sides of Street and to restrict large vehicles from using Battles Street / make it a no truck route.*

Discussion: Have truck team (Brockton Police Department) do enforcement on Battles Street

## **AUGUSTINE STREET**
