

FINANCE COMMITTEE MINUTES

The Standing Committee on Finance met on Monday, October 17, 2016 at 7:00 PM in the Council Chamber with Councilor Cruise presiding. All councilors were present.

1. APPOINTMENT: Christopher O'Reilly to the rank of Fire Lieutenant within the Brockton Fire Department.
PASSED UNDER SUSPENSION OF THE RULES DURING CITY CLERK/COUNCIL MEETING.

2. APPOINTMENT: Joseph DePasquale to the rank of Fire Captain within the Brockton Fire Department.
PASSED UNDER SUSPENSION OF THE RULES DURING CITY CLERK/COUNCIL MEETING.

3. An Ordinance Amending Chapter 20 Streets and Sidewalks of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Brockton enacting a Complete Streets Ordinance.
A motion was made by Councilor Farwell second by Councilor Sullivan as RECOMMENDED FAVORABLY AS AMENDED.
AMEND ARTICLE IV, SUBSECTION "10" Insert words: "When feasible and not overly burdensome to the city"
AMEND SECTION V SUBSECTION "A" The formal exception review panel shall be the Traffic Commission.

4. An Ordinance Amending Revised Ordinances of the City of Brockton, Ch. 5.5 and accepting M. G. L., Chapter 40U in its entirety.

7. RESOLVE: That Mr. Matt O'Brien, Mr. Bill Keene and Mr. Joe Berolini, representatives of the West Cal Ripken Baseball League (f/k/a West Little League) be invited to appear before the Finance Committee to discuss the history of the Albert Baroncelli baseball field and the need and desire to have a new baseball field constructed to meet the needs of the youth within our City.
