The License Commission held its regular monthly meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 18, 2008, in the G.A.R. Room at City Hall. Present were Chairman James E. Holmgren; Commissioners Edward F. Cotter, Paul D. Sullivan, Joseph P. Kelley, Bruce Dansby and Alternate Commissioner Fred Fontaine. Also present were License Agent Lieut. John Crowley; Asst. City Solicitor Phil Nessralla; and Administrative Assistant Bonnie Tucker.

1. Approval of the minutes of the License Commission meeting of October 15, 2008.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cotter to approve the minutes of the meeting which motion was seconded by Commissioner Sullivan. All members voting in the affirmative, the motion carried.

2. Approval of the following police officers as license agents for the month of December, 2008: Lieuts. John Crowley, Thomas LaFratta and John Flynn; Sgts. William Barry and Paul Bonanca; Dets. Michael Schaaf, Erik Hilliard, John Lonergan, Sanford Gurney, James Smith, Dominic Persampieri and Ernie Bell; and Officers Scott Uhlman, and William Healy.

A motion was made by Commissioner Sullivan to approve the police officers as listed as license agents for the month of December, 2008. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Cotter. All members voting in the affirmative, the motion carried.

3. Requests for Special One-day Permits

There were no requests for Special One-day Permits.

4. Hearing on the request from Paula Kuketz to transfer the Lodging House license at 519 Pearl Street to PAK Lodges, LLC.

Present was Paula Kuketz, 33 Lake Avenue, Plymouth, who stated she is requesting to transfer the license from herself as an individual to a limited liability company.

The Adm. Asst. stated that inspection approvals have not been submitted, however, they are in the process of being done for license renewals. Mrs. Kuketz stated the inspectors have been to the location.

A motion was made by Commissioner Kelley to approve the license pending receipt of the inspection approvals which motion was seconded by Commissioner Cotter. All members voting in the affirmative, the motion carried.

5. Hearing on the request from Campello Veteran Fireman's Association – 224 Clinton Street, to appoint James E. Badgio as the manager.

Present was James E. Badgio, 770 Whitman Street, Hanson and Dominic Ricci, 25 Riverview Street, the treasurer of the club.

Paperwork being in order a motion was made by Commissioner Sullivan to approve the appointment of James Badgio as the manager. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Cotter. All members voting in the affirmative, the motion carried.

6. Hearing on the request from U & Asim Corporation for a Common Victualer license at 158 Montello Street.

Present were Haji Ahmad, 7 Richard Street, Attleboro and Charban Iftikhar, 52 Fairview Avenue, Cumberland, RI.

Mr. Iftikhar reviewed their request which is for the Common Victualer license. There will be seating for 19. The Adm. Asst. reviewed that there is no Common Victualer license issued at this location at the present time, however, there was one issued in 2007 to Paula Anne's Café.

The Chairman reviewed the stipulations set out in the zoning decision dated March 8, 2005 and the applicant stated he is aware of them.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cotter to approve the transfer pending receipt of the inspection approvals. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Sullivan. All members voting in the affirmative, the motion carried.

7. Hearing on the request from Antonio Dasilva to transfer the Lodging House license at 1002-1010 Main Street to The Brockton Assets, LLC.

Representing Antonio Dasilva was his wife Vera Dasilva, 11 Fourth Avenue. Also present was Barznab Khan, 279 Centre Street, Boston.

Mr. Khan stated that they had purchased the building and thought the license was transferred.

Paperwork is in order with the exception of the department inspection approvals.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cotter to approve the transfer of the license which motion was seconded by Commissioner Kelley. All members voting in the affirmative, the motion carried.

8. Hearing on the request from Brockton Liquors, Inc. – 379-385 North Main Street, to change officers/directors of the corporation.

Present were Attorney Kevin Reilly, 19 South Main Street, Randolph and Domingas Daviega, 36 Cosma Road, Easton.

Attorney Reilly reviewed that this is a second part to last month's appearance on the transfer of the two Marjoy, Inc. package store licenses. This request is to remove Mr. Daviega's wife, Maria Silva, as a director and officer of the Brockton Liquors, Inc. corporation in order for her to hold the two other package store licenses in the City.

The Adm. Asst. reviewed that the license transfer for the Torrey Street location was held pending this hearing.

A motion was made by Commissioner Cotter to approve the request which motion was seconded by Commissioner Sullivan. All members voting in the affirmative, the motion carried.

9. Communications

Communications were reviewed and it was agreed that hearings will be scheduled in December on violations reported against Rolando's and Rice's Market.

10. Any other business to properly come before the Commission.

Chairman Holmgren requested that in the event that the renewal is filed for Paul Clark's license on Main Street, it be brought to the Commission's attention inasmuch as the business has not been operated for the entire year.

It was agreed that the Commission will meet again on December 10, 2008.

A motion was made by Commissioner Kelley to adjourn the meeting which motion was seconded by Commissioner Cotter. All members voting in the affirmative, the motion carried.
