

**TAPED**

The License Commission held a Special Meeting on Wednesday, August 26, 2009, in Room B7, City Hall, 45 School Street. Present were Commissioners Edward F. Cotter, Bruce G. Dansby and Paul Sullivan; and Administrative Assistant Bonnie Tucker. In Chairman Holmgren's absence, Commissioner Cotter presided.

Items postponed from meeting of August 19, 2009:

- (a) Wine and Malt Beverages – Municipal Environmental Development, Inc. - Gary E. Leonard, Sr., Manager, for three (3) Special One-day Permits to sell wine and malt beverages at 261 Thatcher Street on Saturday, September 5, 2009, from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., on Sunday, September 6, 2009, from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. and on Monday, September 7, 2009, from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Request from Poor Sisters of Jesus Crucified and the Sorrowful Mother, Inc. – Gary Leonard, Manager, to hold a Las Vegas Night function in conjunction with the event planned by the Municipal Environmental Development, Inc. on September 7, 2009 from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Present were Attorney William Pribusauskas, 143 Ridge Street, who stated they are requesting to amend the petition because they have suspended the events for Saturday and Sunday. Therefore, they are requesting only the one wine and malt permit for Monday, September 7, 2009. Also present was Gary E. Leonard, 82 Brian Drive.

The Adm. Asst. stated that along with the one day permit there is an application from the Poor Sisters of Jesus Crucified to hold a Las Vegas Night function in conjunction with the other event.

Attorney Pribusauskas stated that his organization could not apply for the Raffle and Bazaar permit to hold the Las Vegas night function because they have not been organized long enough. A copy of the vendor contract was submitted.

A motion was made by Commissioner Sullivan to approve the one-day permit and the Las Vegas Night function for Monday, September 7, 2009. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Dansby and made unanimous by vote of Commissioner Cotter.

- (b) All Alcoholic Beverages – Brockton Firefighters Local 144 – William E. Hill, Manager, for a fundraiser to be held at 80 Perkins Avenue on Saturday, September 19, 2009, from 12:00 noon to midnight.

Present was William Hill, 80 Ellis Street, who stated this is a fundraising event which is held annually.

A motion was made by Commissioner Sullivan to approve the permit which motion was seconded by Commissioner Dansby and made unanimous by vote of Commissioner Cotter.

- (c) All Alcoholic Beverages – Brockton Firefighters Local 144 – Tim Bamford, Manager, for a fundraiser to be held at 80 Perkins Avenue on Saturday, September 26, 2009, from 12:00 noon to 12:00 midnight.

Present was Tim Bamford, 396 Hillberg Avenue, who stated this request is for the softball tournament fundraiser which is held annually.

A motion was made by Commissioner Dansby to approve the permit which motion was seconded by Commissioner Sullivan and made unanimous by vote of Commissioner Cotter.

With no further business to come before the Commission, a motion was made by Commissioner Dansby to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Sullivan and made unanimous by vote of Commissioner Cotter.
