

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE PARK COMMISSION OF THURSDAY, JUNE 30, 2011

Present were Chairman Thomas Frizzell, Commissioners Billy Anderson, Harold Marrow, George Churchill and Robert King.

The meeting began at 7:00 P.M.

MINUTES: The minutes of the June 23, 2011 meeting were approved as written.

SUPT. OF PARKS INTERVIEWS:

Interviews for the Superintendent of Parks were concluded with the final candidate William Carpenter, being interviewed. Once the interview was completed a short recess was taken before names were submitted for consideration.

After the recess a discussion ensued relative to checking references as a starter and to follow through with the Personnel Department completing a CORI check on the potential candidate.

Commissioner Frizzell asked for members to provide the names of candidates for consideration. Commissioner Churchill said he would like to see Andy Schuckers as a possible choice. Commissioner Frizzell suggested the candidacy of Tim Carpenter based on his experience in the areas of golf course maintenance and related recreation. Commissioner King also agreed to those two choices. Commissioner Marrow supported by Commissioner Anderson recommended the candidacy of William Carpenter.

Commissioner Marrow suggested a vote be taken on the choice of candidates. A motion was made by Commissioner Churchill for candidate Andy Schuckers and was seconded by Commissioner King along with Commissioner Frizzell. Opposed were Commissioners Anderson and Marrow.

By a majority vote it was decided to offer the position to Mr. Schuckers contingent on background checks. If any problems arise then the Commission would meet again for review.

A meeting would be held in a few weeks regarding the background checks.

Having no further business the meeting adjourned at 8:30 P.M.
