

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE PARK COMMISSION OF THURSDAY, AUGUST 11, 2011

Present were Chairman Thomas Frizzell, Sr., Commissioners Billy Anderson, George Churchill and Robert King.

The meeting began at 7:00 P.M.

MINUTES: A motion was made by Commissioner George Churchill and seconded by Commissioner King to accept the minutes of the July 14, 2011 meeting as written.

SUPT. OF PARKS:

Commissioner Frizzell spoke about the process to hire a new Superintendent of Parks and Recreation. Timothy W. Carpenter was selected at the last meeting to assume the position, pending a background and reference check. With the vetting completed, Commissioner Frizzell recommended that based on Mr. Carpenter's seven years experience, his college degree and his certificate in turf management, that his pay start at Step 3 of the negotiated Pay Schedule. A motion to start Timothy W. Carpenter at Step 3 was made by Commissioner Churchill and seconded by Commissioner Anderson. A vote was called and the decision was unanimous. (4-0)

PARK FEES:

A discussion of instituting fees for adult leagues took place. The Commission felt that charging a small fee would give greater control over the use of the fields and more importantly the condition of the field and grounds after they were used. The Commission decided to continue this discussion in more detail when the new Superintendent is in place.

Having no further business the meeting adjourned at 8:05 P.M.
