The License Commission held its regular monthly meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, October 19, 2011 at 6:00 p.m. in the G.A.R. Room at City Hall. Present were Commissioners Scott H. McDuffy, Paul D. Sullivan, Bruce G. Dansby and Alternate Commissioner Kathy Kenney. Also present were License Agent Capt. Emanuel Gomes and Adm. Asst. Bonnie Tucker. In Chairman Kelley's absence, Commissioner McDuffy presided.

1. Approval of the Minutes of the License Commission Meeting of September 28, 2011.

A motion was made by Commissioner Sullivan to approve the minutes of the License Commission meeting of September 28, 2011. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Dansby. All members present voting in the affirmative, the motion carried.

2. Approval of the following police officers as license agents for the month of November, 2011: Capt. Emanuel Gomes; Lieuts. Thomas LaFratta and Paul Bonanca; Sgts Frank Vardaro and Kenneth Lofstrom; Dets. Michael Schaaf, John Lonergan, James Smith and Ernest Bell; and Officer Scott Uhlman.

A motion was made by Commissioner Kenney to approve the police officers as listed as license agents for the month of November, 2011. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Dansby. All members voting in the affirmative, the motion carried.

3. Requests for Special One-day Permits:

- (a) **All Alcoholic Beverages** – Temple Beth Emunah – Reva Castaline, Manager, for an Anniversary Party to be held at 479 Torrey Street on Saturday, November 12, 2011, from 7:30 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.

Present was Reva Castaline, 51 Bassett Road, who stated this is a private function for members of the Temple to celebrate its 60th anniversary. It will be an invitation only event. They will be selling beer, wine and mixed drinks.

In response to questions from Commissioner Sullivan concerning information contained in the application regarding a permit to conduct a lottery, Mrs. Castaline stated there will be no lottery or gambling and that this had been checked in error.

A motion was made by Commissioner Sullivan to approve the special one-day permit which motion was seconded by Commissioner Kenney. All members present voting in the affirmative, the motion carried.

- ADD:** (b) **Wine and Malt Beverages (2 Permits)** – Taunton River Watershed Alliance - Arnold Danielson, Manager, for a Film Festival to be held at the Brockton Public Library – Lingos Room, 304 Main Street, on Friday, November 11, 2011 from 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. and on Saturday, November 12, 2011 from 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Present was Arnie Danielson, 603 Summer Street, who stated he is the project manager of the event. This will be a two day film festival held in the Lingos Room at the main library. Hours will be from 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Food will be provided by Burrito Wraps and beer and wine will be served.

It was reviewed that the Fire Department Permit has not yet been issued inasmuch as the application was filed today.

A motion was made by Commissioner Kenney to approve the two permits pending receipt of the Fire Department permits. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Sullivan. All members present voting in the affirmative, the motion carried.

4. Hearing on the request from Marben, Incorporated dba Supreme Pizza for a Common Victualer license at 1284 Main Street.

Present were Miroslava Rosado, 16 Lucy Lane, president of Marben Incorporated and Yiannos Davos on behalf of the owner of the property, Arcadia Realty, 855 Broadway, Raynham.

Mr. Davos stated this portion of the building has been a pizza shop operated as Piezoni's for approximately five years but closed this year. Ms. Rosado will be operating the restaurant which is adjacent to Supreme Coffee and Donut. In response to questions, Mr. Davos stated that he owns all of the establishments which use the "Supreme" name.

A motion was made by Commissioner Sullivan to approve the Common Victualer license pending receipt of the department inspection approvals. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Dansby. All members voting in the affirmative, the motion carried.

5. **(postpone)** Hearing (postponed from meetings of August 18, 2011 and September 28, 2011) on the charges against Jonas Garcon dba North Star Automotive – 301 North Main Street of the following alleged violations:
 - (a) Registry of Motor Vehicles has notified this board that the dealer plates have been revoked after hearing on May 23, 2011 at which time the hearing officer found that the licensee was not complying with RMV Rules/Regulation and was at fault on violations of
 - (1) Chapter 90, Section 24B RMV Forge/Misuse; and
 - (2) Chapter 90D, Section 32: Misuse of a dealer reassignment form (DRT-1)
 - (b) Failure to keep proper records as required by M.G.L. Chapter 140, Section 62.

This matter was postponed pending receipt of further information from the Registry of Motor Vehicles after an appeal hearing was held on October 18, 2011.

6. Communications

It was reviewed that the Polish White Eagles Club had turned in their liquor license as directed by the ABCC after hearing. The establishment will be closed from October 19 thru November 2, 2011.

Hearings will be scheduled for next month's meeting on alleged violations reported against Max's Blues Café and Bar Dino's.

7. Any other business to properly come before the Commission.

With no further business to come before the Commission, a motion was made by Commissioner Kenney to adjourn the meeting which motion was seconded by Commissioner Dansby. All members voting in the affirmative, the motion carried and the meeting was adjourned.
