

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE PARK COMMISSION OF THURSDAY, JANUARY 12, 2012

Present were Commissioners Harold Marrow, Billy Anderson, George Churchill, and Superintendent Timothy W. Carpenter.

The meeting began at 7:00 P.M.

MINUTES: A motion was made by Commissioner Harold Marrow and seconded by Commissioner Churchill to accept the minutes of the November 10, 2011 meeting as written.

REVIEW OF LETTER TO ADULT LEAGUES:

Superintendent Carpenter presented the letter to be sent to the Adult Leagues regarding the new fees to be charged. Mr. Carpenter shared that there was some concern that field usage may still be by groups not comprised of Brockton residents. Commissioner Anderson pointed out that this is the first year of fees and if changes need to be made in the future the Commission can. The letter was amended slightly to include not only game schedules but practice schedules as well. The letter was approved with the changes. Mr. Carpenter also stated a letter will be going out to the youth leagues before Adult Leagues sign up to insure the youth sports get first priority on which the Commission agreed

SUPERINTENDENT REPORT:

Superintendent Carpenter presented pictures of the progress of the restoration work in D.W. Field Park. The pictures were well received and Commissioner Churchill mentioned some positive feedback regarding the restoration.

Final permitting approval for work on 30 Acre Pond Dam was expected to be completed within a day or so. Hopefully tree work is set to begin in February.

Superintendent Carpenter stated that replacement of the floor behind the lunch counter at the golf course was moving along. The Building Department was very helpful in the process but there was still electrical work that needed to be completed.

Mr. Carpenter stated he is working closely with the Brockton Redevelopment Authority on implementation of the Park Grant. Superintendent Carpenter would like to review the fees at the Golf Course at the next meeting in February.

Having no further business a motion was made by Commissioner Churchill and seconded by Commissioner Marrow to adjourn the meeting at 8:05 P.M.
